A True Story About
**THREE YEARS, THREE MONTHS
IN THREE MEXICAN PRISONS**

(San Diego, CA – August 21, 2009) The infamous *El Pueblito* (little village) penitentiary across the border in Tijuana held four drug stores (heroin, cocaine, crystal meth and marijuana) open 24/7 for prisoner's convenience. Prisoners who have money can rent space in apartments, cells, or on the floor. Others sleep outside on the ground in all weather.

Over 7,000 in a prison built to hold 1,500 that in addition to the inmates, their wives and children are also included. Missionaries come in to trade food for souls. Bodies are chopped up and hauled out with the garbage. Drug lords live in two story villas with spas and servants along with their families. AIDS, hepatitis and TB run rampant with little if any medication.

The *Tales from the Tijuana Jails*, tells many stories of inmates he interviewed including how over 100 American prisoners were protected by a former Special Forces Sergeant and internationally known martial arts expert named Daniel Wooley. After besting five attackers at one time, Daniel became the most powerful man in the prison after the drug lords. He was given the title, "Don," by the drug lords and became a close friend of the prison commandante. Also included are original drawings of the inside of the prison by Joseph Paschen and a foreword by Pat Osio, Jr., a columnist with the San Diego Metropolitan.

The author, Sam Warren, the former publisher of the Santa Ana Journal and former editor of the Uptown San Diego Examiner, was arrested along with all his guests and employees, at his B&B in the beach suburb of Tijuana with all his possessions stolen by the corrupt police. All charges were finally dropped. He will be giving lectures at county libraries and other venues. He is available for interviews and book signings.
